Several volunteers commented that they have always appreciated the value they find in being able to shop in the used bookstore. As volunteers shared their memories I found the stories were based on great times they shared with other volunteers in the library. They all shared that they appreciate this building but they really enjoy their time here in the library with friends. The magazine ladies, Ellen and Kelley, became lifelong friends after they started volunteering with the magazines at the same volunteer shift.

The Friends have about 75 people who volunteer to help make the Friends Board, Book store, and Book Sales a success.

Volunteer Information:

- Bookstore volunteers work an assigned 3.5 hour shift two times a month or once a week. These volunteers sell books and interact with customers.
- Book Management volunteers spend 2-4 hour shifts scanning, sorting, shelving, and stocking books for the Used Bookstore and book sales.
- Book Sale volunteers help prepare and run quarterly book sales.
 Volunteer time for the book sales can be 2 hours, one time to 2-4 hours a day during the sale.
